



# Monongahela Volunteer Project:

## *Cranberry Wilderness Trail Program*

- Start Time for each day is 10:00am
- Volunteers need to bring their own water and lunch
- Appropriate dress required (boots, work gloves, etc.)
- Parking is available at trailheads
- Hand tools will be provided
- Volunteers are responsible for providing tent camping gear for overnights

The Monongahela Volunteer Project (MVP) is a cooperative program between the Appalachian Forest Heritage Area, the West Virginia Highlands Conservancy, and the US Forest Service to increase volunteer presence in the Monongahela National Forest through volunteer events and outings.

Cranberry Wilderness Trail Program is a series of trail work outings in the Cranberry Wilderness area for this summer. Projects will be along the Middle Fork, North Fork and County Line Trails. Workday projects will include drainage work, installing and maintaining water bars, placing stepping stones, cleaning out ditches as well as clearing the trail and brushing. The dates and trails are:

**May 30th – North Fork Trail**

**June 20<sup>th</sup> – County Line Trail**

**July 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> (possible overnight) – Middle Fork Trail**

**July 18<sup>th</sup> – County Line Trail**

**August 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> (possible overnight) – North Fork Trail**

**August 8<sup>th</sup> – Middle Fork Trail**
